**ATTENTION!!!** Green Horse defined as 5YO & Under—Recognition for Year End awards given for Green Horse classes. Cannot show other riding classes.

Entries close at the beginning of the class. All horses on the show grounds must be accompanied by official negative Coggins. Out-of-state horses must have health papers.

<b>Pre-Entry Info</b>	Pre-enter at <a href="http://www.okfqhr.com">www.okfqhr.com</a> (click on Shows then Online Pre-Entry) Pre-entries must be received by <b>midnight on the deadline date</b> . Fees are not paid at time of pre-entry; they will be collected at the show. You will receive confirmation of your pre-entry. If you do not, contact Bryce Tobyne
<b>Entry Fees</b>	\$16 per sanctioned class. \$18 per non-sanctioned class For youth exhibitors showing in three or more classes, \$60 per youth/horse combination show all weekend for youth classes only <sup>1</sup> , and cattle charges will apply
<b>Cattle Charges</b> (In addition to entry fees)	\$60 per Herd Work Class. \$50 first cattle class if you do not enter any herd work classes; \$14 each additional cattle class: same horse/rider combination. Cattle fees are subject to adjustment by the Board prior to Online Pre-entry for any show.
<b>Office Fee</b>	Pre-entry: \$10 or Day of show: \$20 (Per horse/exhibitor combination)
<b>Stalls</b>	\$30 per weekend – nightly rates not available (shavings not included). Stalls must be reserved by Deadline.
<b>Shavings</b>	Priced at market price and subject to change...Price will be posted on <a href="http://www.okfqhr.com">www.okfqhr.com</a> the week before the show. Outside wood shavings allowed – no straw or paper You may place your order for shavings when you arrive. Shavings may be pre-ordered for delivery to your stall, but pre-ordered shavings <b>MUST</b> be paid / picked up even if you do not use them or attend the show.

- Horses competing in sanctioned classes must be registered with FQHR (located in Vicksburg, MI; Call 269-649-1106 or email: [fqhr@gtoast.net](mailto:fqhr@gtoast.net); ). Horse Registrations can **NOT** be done at the show.
- Copy of each horse's FQHR papers & owner's and exhibitor's membership cards must be shown at time of check-in.
  - FQHR and OKFQHR memberships can be purchased at the show.
- All owners and exhibitors must be a FQHR members to show in sanctioned classes and an OkFQHR member to show in any class. FQHR and OkFQHR memberships may be purchased at the show. Youth Exception: Youth may show in Youth classes and not be members of FQHR, but will not accumulate FQHR points.
- Eligibility requirements for Open, Amateur, Novice and Youth classes are in the FQHR Rule Book or on OkFQHR website
- Amateur classes require an FQHR Amateur card; applications can be taken at the show.
- Exhibitors in Beginner Walk-Trot CANNOT have ANY points in ANY performance class. If you **qualified** for year-end awards in any performance class in previous years, you are not eligible to show beginner this year.
- All class additions and scratches must be made in the show office and may not be made only at the arena to get a refund on the class.
- Open Ranch Doctoring, Open Breakaway Roping, Open Ranch Roping, classes may be used to qualify for Amateur Versatility; classes will be pointed as placed regardless of division. Versatility horses must enter their respective Conformation class and their Division Versatility conformation class as well. There is no charge for the Versatility Conformation Class. There is no year end award for Versatility Conformation classes either. Points go only towards versatility.
- Same horse/exhibitor combination must show at three shows in order to qualify for year end awards. Same horse/exhibitor combination must show in two Category classes in three shows to qualify for Category awards.
- Year-end awards may be offered in versatility, high-point, categories and all classes except Green Horse, Versatility Conformation and Lead-line.
- Versatility Award offered in Open, Amateur & Youth divisions. Classes must be declared at the time of entry, prior to deadline of entrants first class. Refer to OkFQHR Versatility Handout for details.
- Alcohol not allowed in arena or barns. Nonsmoking facility. All dogs must be on a leash.

Jackpots may be offered for any class if at least three entries are received. Jackpot rules: Horses do not have to be registered with the FQHR. Exhibitors must be members of FQHR and OKFQHR. Amateur FQHR membership is required for amateur jackpot classes. FQHR horses and members who enter their respective jackpot classes will have their scores/times carried over from the FQHR sanctioned classes to be eligible for the jackpot. Example: you enter open herd work and open jackpot herd work. Your open herd work score is your jackpot score.

At least 3 jackpot entries are required to hold the jackpot class. All breed horses may show as exhibition only if there are not enough entries for a jackpot. In this case, jackpot fees will be waived.

Payout pot will be 80% of jackpot fees.

Payout places will be based on American Cutting Horse Association rules for all jackpot classes.

Jackpot fees will be based on the following schedule in addition to regular entry and office fees above:

Cattle classes: \$50

All other classes: \$30
